<u>SUBJET:</u> REPORTING OF PSC INSPECTIONS/DETENTIONS AND INCIDENTS

1. Purpose

1.1. The purpose of this Circular is to provide guidelines to all parties concerned about the immediate reporting of PSC Inspections/Detentions and incidents which occur to vessels flying the flag of Comoros.

2. **Procedures**

- 2.2 The Master or Owner/Manager of vessels flying the flag of Comoros shall immediately notify the Deputy Commissioner in charge of the vessel and the National Agency of Maritime Affair via e-mail message to info@comorosmaritime.org for:
 - 2.1.1 Any incident, accident or mishap to vessel, crew or passenger;
 - 2.1.2 Port State Control Inspection or Detention of a vessel.
- 2.2 In case of failure of Master or Owner/Manager of a vessel registered under the Comorian flag to comply with the above requirements, this Administration reserves the right to proceed to any action deemed necessary against the vessel, her Owner or any other related entity.
